

Fire and Emergency Services Superannuation Fund Nomination of Preferred Beneficiary Form

In the event of your death, the Superannuation Board **may** pay your superannuation entitlement directly to:

1. your spouse, including your de facto spouse;
2. your child or children (including stepchildren and adopted children); and
3. any other person who is financially dependent on you.

Alternatively, the Superannuation Board may pay the benefit to your estate (or legal personal representative) in which case a contact person should be noted on this form and the word "Estate" entered where you are asked for "Relationship".

It is important that you update your Nomination of Preferred Beneficiary form and your will as your personal circumstances change.
